The awards offer teams, groups or organisations in the public, private, voluntary or co-operative sectors an opportunity to share their achievements with colleagues across West Wales.

We are seeking nominations in the following categories:

Achieving transformation through innovation award

This category is to celebrate:

- A team or individual that has made a change which has had a positive impact on staff, patients or care.
- Demonstrated innovation or having made a change, be it small or large, that has had a positive impact.
- Improved a process or system which has had a positive impact on staff, service or care.
- Ensured that any changes made were in line with policies or best practice guidance.
- Worked together across different roles / settings in a collaborative approach to make a positive change.

Supporting and investigating in the wellbeing of the health and social care workforce award

This category is to celebrate:

- A team or project that has significantly impacted wellbeing.
 - Has had a positive impact on the wellbeing of staff beyond the requirements of their role.
 - Has implemented a wellbeing workforce initiative or resource beyond the requirements of their role.
 - Has measured success of the outcomes of the team or project.
 - Has demonstrated that workforce wellbeing is at the heart of the work.

Integrated Care award

This category is to celebrate:

- Where joint arrangements and integrated working have improved the lives of our citizens.
 - Has clearly demonstrated positive impact by working seamlessly across organisational or geographical borders.
 - Has enabled an improvement in the lives of West Wales citizens.
 - Has brought about positive change through adopting an integrated care approach.
 - Can identify measurable improvements through integrated care.

Team award

This category is to celebrate:

- The team who have shown excellence in collaboration and partnership working.
- Has clearly demonstrated positive impact by forming, developing or modernising a team.
- Has enabled an improvement in the lives of West Wales citizens.
- Has brought about positive change through team working.
- Can identify measurable improvements through team working, collaboration and partnership working.

User Involvement award

This category is to celebrate:

- A project or a team who have demonstrated true co-production and continuous user led leadership and collaboration.
- Has demonstrated a positive impact on a service, project or team via genuine co-production.
- Can identify the key factors that led to comprehensive user involvement.
- Can demonstrate a service, project or team that was co-designed and delivered by users within West Wales.
- Can identify measurable improvements achieved through user involvement and co-production.

Outstanding achievement award

This category is to celebrate:

- The individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the health and social sector in West Wales during their lifetime.
- Worked in the health and social care sector (paid or unpaid) for 25 years or more (this does NOT need to be continuous or for the same organisation).
- Can demonstrate the positive impact they have had on health and social care in West Wales had a positive impact on the service.
- Improved health and social care for the citizens of West Wales.
- Can identify measurable improvements through the work and achievements of this individual.

Nominations

The 2022 West Wales Regional Partnership Board Awards will give us an opportunity to showcase the excellent work that's been happening across West Wales, and we're looking forward to recognising, celebrating and sharing that practice.

Nominations are invited from all who are part of the health and social care sector in West Wales, including teams, groups or organisations in the public, private, voluntary or co-operative communities.
